The first plays downhill and the invitation to "Let Er Fly" is apt. Use judgement in placing the second shot because out-of-bounds left and a bunker right can wreak havoc with your score. A pond guards the right side of the large, rolling green.

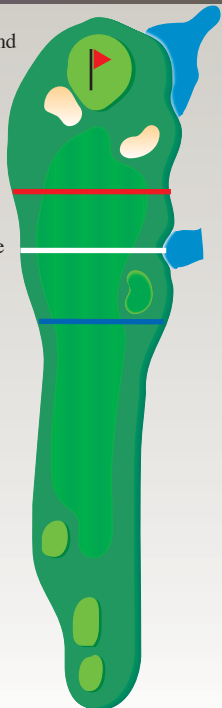

A short par 4, but "Heartbreak Ridge" lurks in the woods to the right. Be aggressive with your approach because of the gathering bunker to the front right of the green.

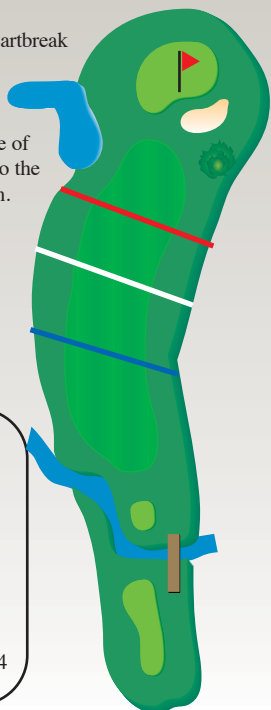

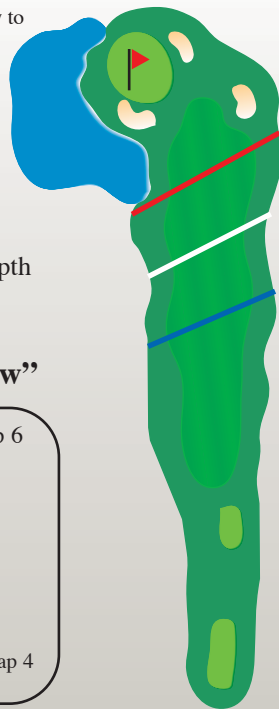

Play from an elevated tee over rolling mounds or take the shortcut over the tall pines that stand directly between you and the flag. Avoid the deep bunker in front of the green.

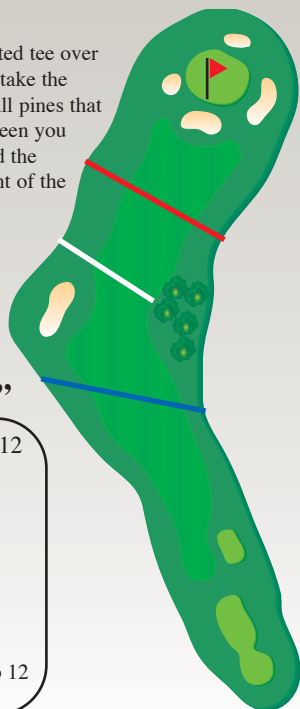

There is nothing nice about this “spice.” Usually a long iron into the prevailing wind to a subtly undulating green tightly guarded by devilish bunkers.

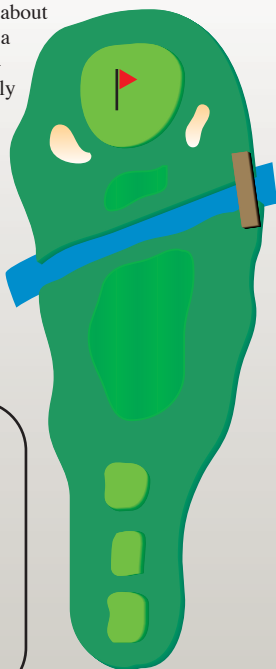
